

COURSE DESCRIPTION

A didactic official Fetal Medicine Foundation USA certificate program in 11-13+6 Week Scan, and NT/NB/TF/freeBeta/PAPP-A screening has been combined with a hands-on ultrasound laboratory to allow learned material to be perfected in a practical setting. The FMF NT, NB, and TF Standard Certificates are a two step process. This non-profit course provides the didactic NT/NB/TF Course Certificates (step 1). The Practical Exam Certificates follows with submission of NT and then NB and TF films (step 2).

COURSE OBJECTIVES

At the conclusion of the conference participants should be able to:

1. Describe methods of First Trimester prenatal NT, NB, TF, and biochemical screening for chromosomal, heart and other abnormalities and perinatal risk.
2. Describe First Trimester NT, NB, and TF biochemical and other ultrasound markers.
3. Discuss how the combination of NT/NB/freeBeta/PAPP-A detects 91% to 97% of Down syndrome, trisomy-18 and -13.
4. Explain the clinical and patient counseling issues regarding First Trimester Prenatal Screening and Pregnancy Management Protocol.
5. perform an 11-13 week ultrasound examination, measure NTs and assess the NBs and TFs.

Physicians, sonographers, midwives, nurse practitioners and genetic counselors will benefit from attending.

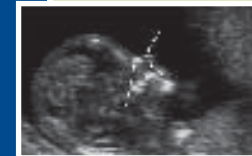

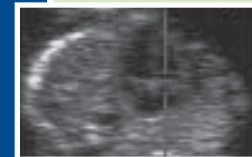

NOTE: Each person performing Nuchal Translucency (NT), Nasal Bone (NB), and Tricuspid Flow (TF) assessments should attend a standardized certificate course and maintain external QC. Each attendee is responsible for submitting films after the course to obtain FMF NT, NB and TF Practical Certificates. NT, NB, and TF should always be provided with freeBeta/PAPP-A to reduce screen positives to 2% and increase detection from 80% to 95%. Genetic Counselors and other prenatal health care providers should attend this pregnancy management course and receive an FMF course certificate and CEU certificate.
